2 TAKE A SHORT SHOWER INSTEAD OF A BATH.



3 IF YOU FIND A LEAK OR A DRIPPING TAP IN THE PLACE YOU ARE STAYING, PLEASE LET THE MANAGER OR OWNER KNOW.



4 IF YOU ARE SELF-CATERING, PLEASE ONLY USE WASHING MACHINES AND DISHWASHERS WHEN YOU HAVE A FULL LOAD.



5 BEDDING AND TOWELS DO NOT NEED WASHING EVERY DAY. SAVE WATER AND A CHORE BY REUSING THEM.
